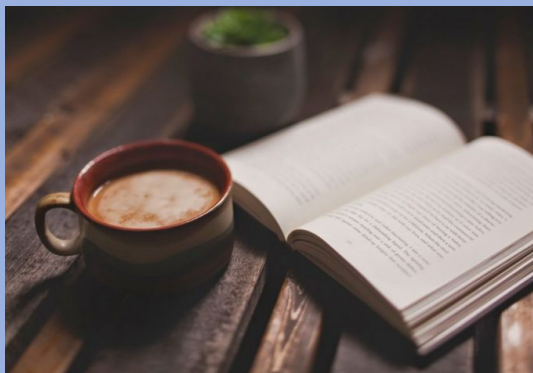

"Farewell, My Lovely" by Raymond Chandler

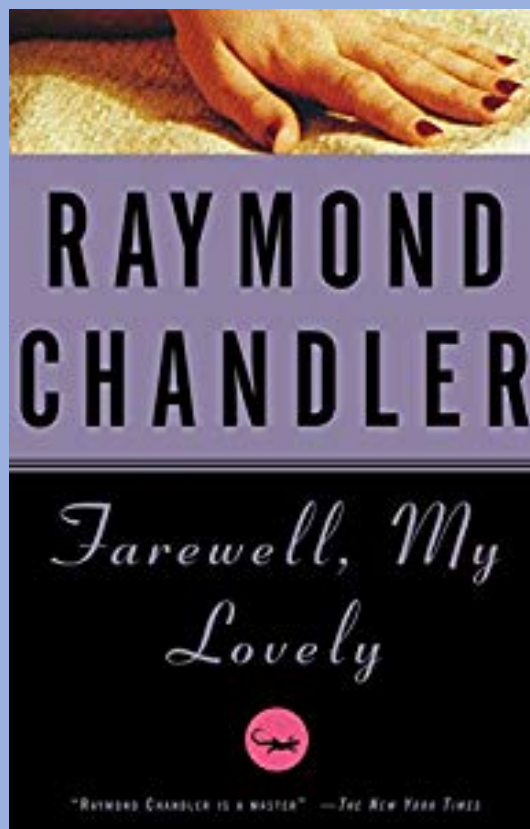
